Special Session

The Council for the Incorporated Town of Winamac met in special session on July 20, 2016, at 7:00 a.m. in the Winamac Town Hall, Town Clerk-Treasurer's Office with the following board members in attendance: Tom J. Murray, Dan Vanaman, Judy Heater and Jim Watkins. Also attending were Melanie A. Berger, Clerk-Treasurer; Bradley Zellers, Town Manager and Wastewater Superintendent; Jeremy Beckner, Water and Street Superintendent; Tony Chrisman, E & B Paving; and Scott Hinkle and Kurt Brandstatter, Central Paving. Town Attorney Justin Schramm arrived at the meeting at 7:23 a.m.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 a.m. by Council President, Tom J. Murray.

Kurt Brandstatter with Central Paving spoke to the Council. He stated that there have been a lot of changes with this bid. He said he received an e-mail yesterday at 1:00 p.m. with changes and they did not have enough time to bid those changes and get the bid bond. Typically if there is a change in specifications, it would delay the bid and it would be a responsibility of the Town to delay the bid process. Central Paving would like to give a bid. He said if there are changes, typically they give an extra week because of the changes. Kurt is asking that the bids be returned and given 48 hours to rebid the job. The Council will postpone the bid opening until Friday, July 22, 2016 at 8:00 a.m.




Two businesses have looked at the garbage truck. The bucket truck will go to auction with a reserve.
