

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING
ORDINANCE NO. 14 OF 2018**

Ordinance No. 9 of 2019

WHEREAS, the Town Council for the Town of Winamac, Indiana (the “**Town Council**”) previously passed Ordinance No. 14 of 2018, An Ordinance Establishing a Policy for the Collection of Service Fees from Property Owners for a Tenant’s Delinquency; and

WHEREAS, after passage of said Ordinance, the Indiana legislature passed HEA 1347, which effectively renders Ordinance No. 14 of 2018 null and void, excepting therefrom attempts by the Town of Winamac (the “**Town**”) to collect sewer/wastewater delinquencies; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council is now desirous of repealing the aforementioned Ordinance No. 14 of 2018, in its entirety; and


WHEREAS, despite the repeal of Ordinance No. 14 of 2018, the Town reserves the right to continue to pursue property owners for any delinquency related to services provided by the Town’s sewer/wastewater department, either pursuant to written policy by the Town Clerk-Treasurer, or by Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Council of the Town of Winamac, Indiana, that Ordinance No. 14 of 2018 is now repealed, in its entirety, as of the date of the passage of this Ordinance.






